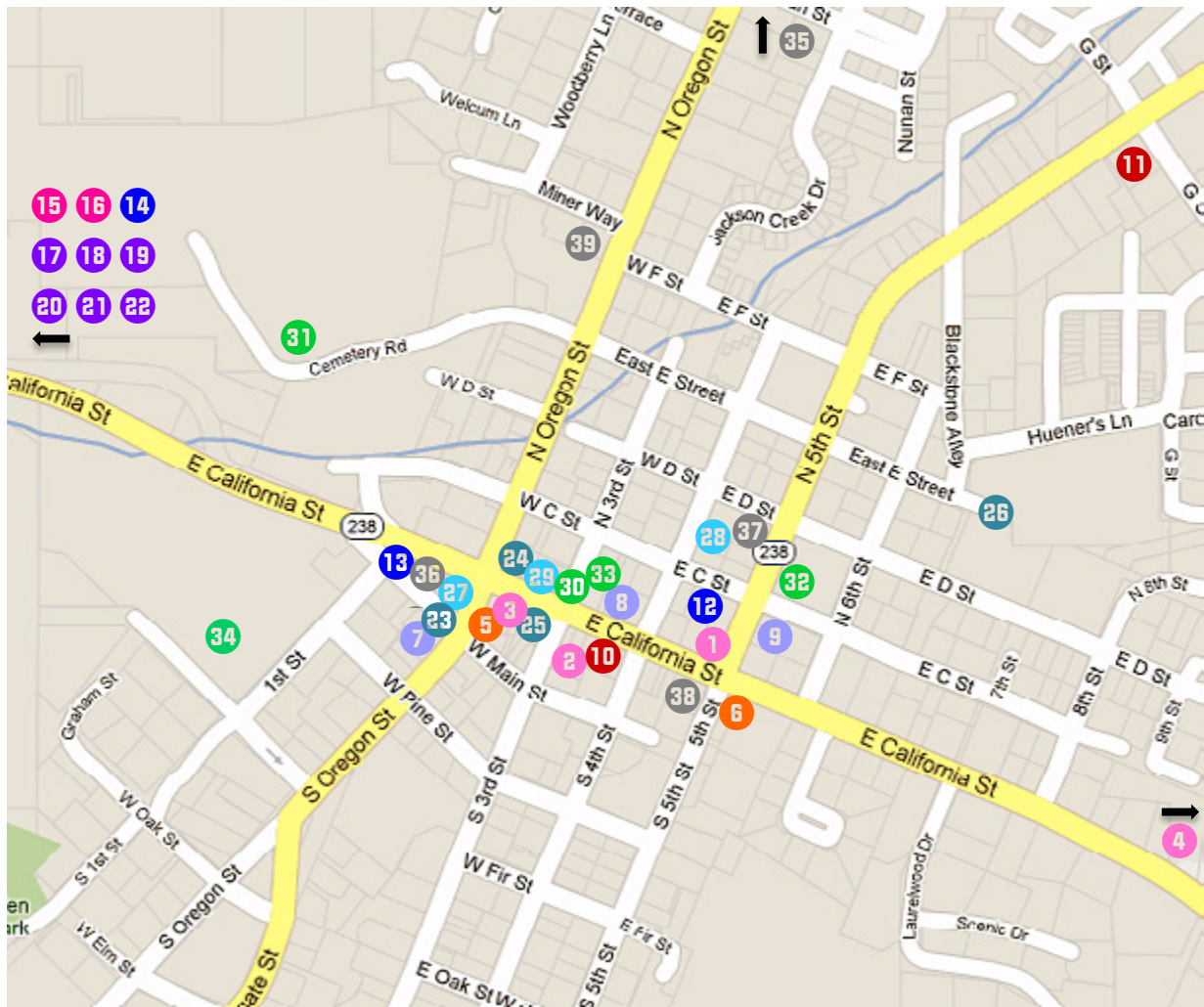
12PM: ONE WALK FOR THE ROAD

Or, browse the **JACKSONVILLE FARMERS' MARKET** (Sundays, 10am-3pm), followed by the **HISTORIC JACKSONVILLE TROLLEY TOUR**. And then, if you really must, sniff, sob, it's time to head home.
